KIOLAKAA-KEAA HOMESTEAD LOTS.

KAU, HAWAII.

Lot 24.

Beginning at triangle mark on solid rock and ahu at Keohe, 210 feet makai of middle of Government Road and 31 feet mauka of stone wall at a point whose coordinates referred to Akihi Trig. Station are 10627.6 feet S. and 12516.9 feet E. and from which Ka-lua-puhi Trig. Station bears S 74° 30' W true, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running as follows by true bearings; all points being marked by + on stone and ahu, except as otherwise described:-

1. N 3° 10' W 1563 feet along Lot 7 and across Government road;
2. N 81° 10' E 1317 feet along Lot 23 to + on pahoehoe and ahu;
3. S 16° 35' W 366 feet along Government reservation for 40 foot road;
4. S 17° 12' W 847 feet along the same;
5. S 15° 52' W 618 feet along the same and crossing Government road to a point 34 feet makai of stone wall;
6. S 78° 25' W 705 feet along Grant 2759, S. Nakaikuaana;
7. N 3° 10' W 123 feet along Lot 7 to the initial point and containing an area of 37-3/10 Acres; exclusive of a Government reservation, 60 feet wide, through which the Government road passes.
