Claimed by Mrs. Emily Wilkins of Lahaina and John Kaluna of Paia, Maui.

Beginning at a point on the makai side of Main Street at the East corner of this lot being the North corner of L.C.A. 299 to Kanehaku, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Launiupoko" being North 11036 feet and West 14560 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 1193, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $60^{\circ} 45'$  88 feet along L.C.A. 299 to Kanehaku;
2.  $155^{\circ} 50'$  106 feet along <sup>L.C.A. 8515 to Keone Ana and</sup> L.C.A. 277 to W.C. Lunailo (Luaehu);
3.  $238^{\circ} 50'$  77 feet along road;
4.  $329^{\circ} 45'$  108 feet along Main Street to the initial point.
