

-DESCRIPTION OF GOVERNMENT LOT XXV. AT PAAUILO, HAMAKUA, HAWAII.

Commencing at the South-East corner of this Lot on the North side of the Govt. Road at a point marked by a post branded XXV. the boundary runs thence:

N. 08° 55' E., 1803 feet to the North-West corner of Govt.

Reserve a point marked by a post near a tree branded XXV. near the bottom of the stream; thence

N. 36° 07' E., 1005 feet down the gulch to the North-East corner of this Lot, the stream bed being the boundary; thence

N. 55° 43' W., 700 feet; and

N. 58° 45' W., 690 feet to the North-West corner of this Lot, a point marked by a post on the East side of Govt.

Reserve; thence

S. 17° 09' W., 3289 feet along Govt. Reserve to the line of the North side of Govt. Road; thence

\* N. ~~58° 45'~~<sup>58 45</sup> E., 195 feet along said North side of Govt. Road;

S. 64° 10' E., 113 feet do. do.

N. 28° 00' E., 140 feet do. do.

S. 78° 40' E., 66 feet do. do.
