Beginning at a pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 24 on the West side of homestead road, the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahiha" being: 2882.8 feet North and 6170.5 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 87° 56' 1369.7 feet along Lot 24 to a pipe;
2. 175° 20' 700.25 feet along Lot 26 and across a small stream to a pipe 10 feet from the edge of a stream;
3. Easterly along a line parallel to and 10 feet from the edge of the stream to a pipe near a bridge, the direct azimuth and distance being: 287° 12' 1403.7 feet;
4. 349° 42' 136.5 feet along West side of homestead road to a pipe;
5. 328° 41' 116.2 feet along West side of homestead road to the point of beginning.
