Beginning at a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 26, and on the East side of Kapehu Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 3112.3 feet South and 4349.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $311^{\circ} 15'$ 1240.2 feet along Lots 26B and 26A, to a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. $36^{\circ} 22'$ 79.8 feet along West side of Kapehu Road;
3. $64^{\circ} 03'$ 166.7 feet along top of West edge of Kapehu gulch;
4. $351^{\circ} 31'$ 164.5 feet across small gulch;
5. $349^{\circ} 35'$ 394.1 feet along top of West edge of Kapehu gulch to a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
6. $131^{\circ} 15'$ 1287.8 feet along Lot 24 to a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
7. $198^{\circ} 56'$ 69.4 feet along East side of Kapehu Road;
8. $196^{\circ} 25'$ 267.5 feet along same;
9. $146^{\circ} 44'$ 175.1 feet along same;
10. $207^{\circ} 14'$ 159.9 feet along same;
11. $234^{\circ} 12'$ 76.3 feet along same to the point of beginning.
