Beginning at a + on stone at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 26 and on the South side of Government road, from which point the true azimuth and distance to Trig. Station "Paper" is $127^{\circ} 55'$ 632.2 feet, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaluamoa" are 6305.1 feet South and 979.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2493, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $294^{\circ} 50'$ 178.2 feet along South side of Government road to a + on stone;
2. $276^{\circ} 38'$ 157.3 feet along South side of Government road to a + on stone;
3. $15^{\circ} 34'$ 1348.7 feet along Lot 24 across three ditches to a + on stone on the North side of road to Kukuiula;
4. $104^{\circ} 08'$ 331.4 feet along North side of road to Kukuiula to a + on stone at the intersection of a 30 foot plantation road;
5. $195^{\circ} 34'$ 1360.9 feet along Lot 26 to the point of beginning.

Area 10-20/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom rights-of-way 15 feet wide across this lot for the³ditches, said rights-of-way containing an area of 10/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 10-10/100 ACRES.
