Waiohonu-Kakio Homesteads
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Beginning at a + cut on stone at the South corner of this lot and the East corner of Lot 26 and at junction of 20 and 30 foot roads, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puuiki" being 2413.7 feet North and 3344.6 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2547, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 122° 48' 185.0 feet along road to a + cut on stone;
2. 252° 33' 250.6 feet along road to a + cut on stone;
3. 191° 28' 260.8 feet along road to a + cut on stone;
4. 161° 24' 30" 249.0 feet along road to a + cut on stone;
5. 204° 35' 126.1 feet along road to a + cut on stone;
6. 107° 51' 537.6 feet along L.C.A. 4940 apana 2 to Keaulana to a + cut on stone;
7. 21° 51' 275.9 feet along Grant 2939 to Kauimakaole to a + cut on stone under pile of stones;
8. 31° 51' 156.0 feet along Grant 2939 to Kauimakaole to a + cut on stone;
9. Thence to bottom of small gully and along the stream, the direct azimuth and distance being:- 313° 28' 810.4 feet to the point of beginning.
