Beginning at a + on a stone in the center of Alenaio Gulch, said cross being the E A S T corner of this Lot and the S O U T H corner of Lot 28, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Haiku" being 634.0 feet South and 3633.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map NO. 2568 and running by true azimuths as follows:-

1. Along the center of the Alenaio Gulch to a + on a stone, the direct azimuth and distance being: $43^{\circ} 31'$ 1703.3 feet;
2. $135^{\circ} 33'$ 56.0 feet along Lot 24/25 and across Piha Road to a pipe;
3. $135^{\circ} 33'$ 727.3 feet along Lot 24/25 to a pipe at the top of the South edge of Waikaumalo Gulch;
4. Thence along the top of the South edge of Waikaumalo Gulch to a pipe, the direct azimuth and distance being: $239^{\circ} 04'$ 1750.6 feet;
5. $315^{\circ} 30'$ 231.3 feet along Lot 28 to a pipe on the North side of the Piha Road;
6. $315^{\circ} 30'$ 82.5 feet along Lot 28 and across Piha Road to the point of beginning.

Containing an Area of 20-20/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a strip of land thirty feet wide for a public road, said road strip containing an area of 1-35/100 acres and also excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way of 10 feet for the flume across this lot, said right of way containing an area of 10/100 acres, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 18-75/100 Acres.
