Beginning at an iron rail at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 24 and on the East side of 40 foot road, the coordinates of said iron rail referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauhikoa" being 3348.3 feet North and 4752.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2466, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 246° 30' 944.0 feet along Lot 24 to an iron rail on the West edge of East Kuiaha Gulch;
2. Thence following up along West edge of East Kuiaha Gulch to an iron rail at the Southeast corner of this lot, the direct azimuth and distance being 357° ~~20'~~ 1890.0 feet;
3. ^{67° 50' 403.0} ~~44° 45' 295.0~~ feet along the land owned by the Haiku Sugar Co.
4. 163° 18' ^{740.0} ~~764.8~~ feet along 40 foot road;
5. 158° 58' 1023.6 feet along 40 foot road to the point of beginning.

Excepting and reserving the East Kuiaha Stream and all riparian and other rights in or to this stream and the waters thereof.
