Hamakua, Hawaii.

Beginning at a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galvanized iron pipe at the North corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 25, on the East side of Kahawai Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalanial" being 6927.5 feet North and 2486.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $299^{\circ} 59'$  738.8 feet along Lot 25 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe on top of West edge of Kalopa Gulch;
2. Thence following along top of West edge of Kalopa Gulch to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch iron pipe, the direct azimuth and distance being:  $22^{\circ} 05'$  1277.9 feet;
3.  $159^{\circ} 40'$  1132.8 feet along the East side of Kahawai Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
4.  $205^{\circ} 30'$  544.0 feet along same to the point of beginning.
