Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 25, on the East side of Kapehu Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 3112.3 feet South, and 4349.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 234° 12' 64.6 feet along East side of Kapehu Road;
2. 180° 04' 145.3 feet along East side of Kapehu Road;
3. 212° 53' 208.6 feet along East side of Kapehu Road;
4. 285° 32' 83.7 feet along East side of Kapehu Road;
5. 263° 26' 182.8 feet along East side of Kapehu Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
6. 311° 15' 659.4 feet along South side of Kapehu Road;
7. 41° 15' 550.9 feet along Lot 26A;
8. 131° 15' 745.8 feet along Lot 25 to the point of beginning.
