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Beginning at an angle iron and ahu at the South corner of this lot, the West corner of Camp Reserve and on the North side of North Road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kamakamaka" being 5991.1 feet North and 7913.5 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2441, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 91° 05' 30" 161.5 feet along North Road to an angle iron and ahu;
2. 113° 35' 2883.7 feet along Lot 26 to an angle iron and ahu;
3. 172° 35' 30" 1755.3 feet along Government Land to a forest reserve monument;
4. 218° 04' 36.0 feet along Kau Forest Reserve to South side of flume right-of-way;
5. 312° 08' 4059.5 feet along South side of flume right-of-way;
6. 29° 26' 30" 90.6 feet along Camp Reserve to a + on rock;
7. 340° 58' 130.6 feet along Camp Reserve to the point of beginning.

Area 63-73/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide across this lot for the flume, area 71/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 63-02/100 ACRES.
