Revised Description.

Lot 27.

Hakalau Homesteads,
S. Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at an iron rail at the West corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 23 and on the East side of 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 16634.5 feet North and 4900.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2574, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 236° 55' 1474.0 feet along Lot 23, 22 and 21 to an iron rail;
2. 326° 55' 375.0 feet along Lots 25 and 26 to an iron rail;
3. 57° 05' 1559.2 feet along Lot 28 to an iron rail on the East side of 40 foot road;
4. 159° 53' 380.0 feet along 40 foot road to the point of beginning.

Area 12-97/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide across this lot for the flume, said right-of-way containing an area of 33/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 12-64/100 ACRES.
