Beginning at a pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 28 and on the North side of homestead road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahiha" being: 2392.1 feet North and 8495.1 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 158° 34' 1098.6 feet along Lot 28 to a pipe 10 feet from the edge of a stream;
2. Easterly along a line parallel to and 10 feet from the edge of the stream to a post, the direct azimuth and distance being: 260° 18' 739.8 feet;
3. 355° 20' 1077.0 feet along Lot 26 to a pipe on the North side of homestead road;
4. 79° 55' 422.0 feet along North side of homestead road to the point of beginning.
