1. $254^{\circ} 51'$ 151.8 feet along Lot 31 to a redwood post;
2. $265^{\circ} 38'$ 82.0 feet along Lot 32 to a redwood post;
3. $00^{\circ} 30'$ 124.2 feet along Lot 27 to a redwood post;
4. $1^{\circ} 44'$ 103.5 feet along Lot 26;
5. $84^{\circ} 12'$ 71.3 feet along Lot 26 to a redwood post;
6. $89^{\circ} 52'$ 123.2 feet along Lot 25 to a redwood post;
7. $171^{\circ} 03'$ 191.5 feet along Lot 29 to the initial point.
