Beginning at triangle mark on stone at Kaohuku at a point whose coordinates referred to "Akihi" Trig. Station are 9140.0 feet S. and 2813.2 feet E. and from which "Ka-lua-olai" Trig. Station bears S 21° 50' W true, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running as follows by true bearings; all points being marked by + on stone and ahu, unless otherwise described:-
