## Revised Description.

Lot 29.

Hakalau Homesteads,  
S. Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at an iron rail at the Northwest corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 28 and on the East side of 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 15996.0 feet North and 5134.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2574, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 244° 44' 1582.4 feet along Lot 28 to an iron rail;
2. 316° 30' 140.0 feet along Grant 1043 to Kapou and Samuela to post;
3. 323° 30' 528.0 feet along Grant 1043 to Kapou and Samuela to post  
10 feet from edge of Kaahakini Stream;
4. Thence along a line parallel to and 10 feet from edge of the Kaahakini Stream to an iron rail near bridge on the South side of 40 foot road, the direct azimuth and distance being 77° 42' 2282.5 feet;
5. 245° 00' 228.0 feet along 40 foot road to an iron rail;
6. 237° 10' 260.0 feet along 40 foot road to an iron rail;
7. 159° 53' 106.0 feet along 40 foot road to the point of beginning.
