Beginning at a small ohia tree marked XXIX and XXX at the East corner of this lot at the road reserve, the coordinates of which point are 7180.0 feet South and 4939.2 feet West of Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No, 2256, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $58^{\circ} 59'$ ^{15'} 1660.0 feet along Lot 30;
2. $118^{\circ} 30'$ 719.2 feet along Government land to a post on the South-east edge of Kaiwilahilahi Gulch;
3. Along the Southeast edge of said gulch, the direct azimuth and distance being: $249^{\circ} 30'$ 1982.0 feet to the road reserve;
4. $310^{\circ} 30'$ 250.0 feet along 50 foot road reserve to the point of beginning.
