Beginning at a + on stone at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 27 and on the North side of Government road, from which point the true azimuth and distance to Trig. Station "Paper" is $114^{\circ} 08' 40''$ 1113.1 feet, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalua-moa" are 6371.9 feet South and 462.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No 2493, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $174^{\circ} 32'$ 841.2 feet along Lot 27 across two ditches to a + on stone at the Southwest corner of Reservoir No. 18 lot;
2. $259^{\circ} 30'$ 190.2 feet along Reservoir No. 18 lot to a + on stone;
3. $337^{\circ} 12'$ 188.8 feet along Reservoir No. 18 lot to a + on stone;
4. $286^{\circ} 49'$ 376.0 feet along Reservoir No. 18 lot across ditches to a + on stone;
5. $354^{\circ} 09'$ 661.5 feet along Lot 30 across a ditch to a + on stone on the North side of Government road;
6. $96^{\circ} 39'$ 610.0 feet along North side of Government road across a ditch to the point of beginning.

Area 10-40/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom rights-of-way 15 feet wide across this lot for the ²ditches, said rights-of-way containing an area of 48/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 9-92/100 ACRES.
