Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot, the East corner of Kahawai and Middle Roads, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniai" being 3499.8 feet North and 1377.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $255^{\circ} 00'$ 1159.6 feet along South side of Kahawai Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe on top of West edge of Kalopa Gulch;
2. Thence following along top of West edge of Kalopa Gulch, the direct azimuths and distances being:
 $353^{\circ} 00'$ 490.0 feet;
 $27^{\circ} 00'$ 360.0 feet;
 $61^{\circ} 00'$ 340.0 feet;
 $30^{\circ} 32'$ 481.3 feet to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. $170^{\circ} 03'$ 738.1 feet along the Northeast side of Middle Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. $136^{\circ} 00'$ 500.0 feet along the Northeast side of Middle Road to the point of beginning.
