Beginning at a stake between two pieces of angle iron and ahu at the West corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 29, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kamakakaka" being: 9609.0 feet North and 10379.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2441, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 218° 04' 667.1 feet along the Kau Forest Reserve to an angle iron and ahu;
2. 312° 17' 30" 4591.4 feet along Lot 31 crossing flume right-of-way to an angle iron and ahu;
3. 62. 29' 30" 414.4 feet along North Road to an angle iron and ahu;
4. 128° 42' 4408.2 feet along Lot 29 crossing flume right-of-way to the point of beginning.

Area 54-24/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide across this lot for the flume, said right-of-way containing an area of 32/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 53-92/100 ACRES.
