S. Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at an iron rail at the North corner of this lot and the South corner of Mountain Road and a 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 17439.7 feet North and 4528.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2574, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 337° 53' 880.0 feet along 40 foot road to an iron rail;
2. 339° 53' 155.0 feet along 40 foot road to an iron rail;
3. 58° 00' 494.5 feet along Lot 35 to an iron rail;
4. 148° 07' 912.6 feet along Lot 31 to an iron rail on the South side of Mountain Road;
5. 238° 55' 300.0 feet along Mountain Road to an iron rail;
6. 224° 00' 195.0 feet along Mountain Road to an iron rail;
7. 217° 10' 201.0 feet along Mountain Road to the point of beginning.

Area 12-49/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide across this lot for the flume, said right-of-way containing an area of 13/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 12-36/100 ACRES.
