Beginning at a Forest Reserve Monument (marked "Forest 2") at the North corner of this lot and the West corner of Lot 32, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kanakakaka" being: 10404.7 feet North and ~~8756.2~~^{9776.2} feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2441, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 309° 35' 4613.6 feet along Lot 32 crossing flume right-of-way to an angle iron and ahu;
2. 20° 35' 30" 210.7 feet along North Road to an angle iron and ahu;
3. 48° 24' 30" 249.3 feet along North Road to an angle iron and ahu;
4. 62° 29' 30" 127.1 feet along North Road to an angle iron and ahu;
5. 132° 17' 30" 4591.4 feet along Lot 30 crossing flume right-of-way to angle iron and ahu;
6. 218°.04' 343.6 feet along the Kau Forest Reserve to the point of beginning.

Area 48-54/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide across this lot for the flume, said right-of-way containing an area of 17/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 48-37/100 ACRES.
