Beginning at a Forest Reserve Monument (marked "Forest 2") at the West corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 31, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kamakakaka" being; 10404.7 feet North and 8756.2 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2441, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 254° 28' 1490.0 feet across gulch along the Kau Forest Reserve crossing flume right-of-way to a Forest Reserve Monument (Marked "Forest Flume");
2. 325° 08' 3893.7 feet along Lot 33 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu in center of gulch;
3. 36° 37' 181.1 feet along North Road to an angle iron and ahu;
4. 129° 35' 4613.6 feet along Lot 31 crossing flume right-of-way to the point of beginning.

Area 72-54/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide across this lot for the flume, said right-of-way containing an area of 16/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 72-38/100 ACRES.
