Beginning at a pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 31 and on the South side of homestead road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahiha" being: 1975.9 feet North and 5560.7 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 276° 40' 319.4 feet along South side of homestead road to a pipe;
2. 299° 41' 248.4 feet along South side of homestead road and across a stream to a pipe;
3. 341° 25' 166.0 feet along West side of homestead road to a pipe;
4. 70° 19' 261.1 feet along homestead road to a pipe;
5. 25° 41' 366.0 feet along homestead road to a pipe;
6. 38° 25' 148.75 feet along homestead road to a pipe;
7. 52° 44' 209.0 feet along homestead road to a pipe;
8. 98° 21' 406.5 feet along homestead road to a pipe on the boundary of Papaikou;
9. 116° 30' 168.0 feet along the land of Papaikou to a pipe;
10. 216° 40' 1049.8 feet along Lot 31 and across a stream to the point of beginning.
