Beginning at an ohia tree marked Δ at the North corner of this lot and on the Southeast edge of Kaiwilahilahi Gulch on the line of Grant 4287 to Geo. H. Angus, the coordinates of which point are 6237.5 feet South and 3993.4 feet West of Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2256, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $303^{\circ} 57'$ 378.8 feet along Grant 4287 to Geo. H. Angus;
2. $28^{\circ} 30'$ 1353.7 feet along Lot 33;
3. $130^{\circ} 30'$ 996.5 feet along 50 foot road reserve to an ohia tree marked XXXII on the Southeast edge of Kaiwilahilahi Gulch;
4. Along the Southeast edge of said gulch, the direct azimuth and distance being: $235^{\circ} 19'$ 1324.8 feet to the point of beginning.
