Hanalei Homesteads, Halelea, Kauai.

Beginning at a redwood post at the Southeast corner of this lot, *on the bank of the Hanalei River,* and the Northeast corner of Lot 27, Government Survey Trig. Station "Paina" is by true azimuth and distance  $31^{\circ} 50'$  2783.6 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2262, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $84^{\circ} 00'$  287.4 feet along Lot 27;
2.  $357^{\circ} 48'$  65.6 feet along Lot 27 to a redwood post;
3.  $85^{\circ} 38'$  82.0 feet along Lot 28 to a redwood post;
4.  $171^{\circ} 50'$  174.1 feet along Lot 31 to a redwood post;
5.  $255^{\circ} 42'$  105.4 feet along Lot 34 to a redwood post;
6.  $267^{\circ} 50'$  120.7 feet along Lot 34 to a redwood post;
7.  $257^{\circ} 48'$  151.8 feet along Lot 33;
8.  $336^{\circ} 55'$  46.0 feet along hau fence <sup>on the West side of</sup> and the Hanalei River;
9.  $359^{\circ} 32'$  91.0 feet along hau fence <sup>West bank of the</sup> and the Hanalei River to the initial point.
