Beginning at a Forest Reserve Monument (marked "Forest Flume") at the West corner of this lot, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kamakamaka" being: 10804.9 feet North and 8318.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2441, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 310° 35' 3926.5 feet along the Kau Forest Reserve to a Forest Reserve Monument (marked "Forest Ohia");
2. 40° 38' 378.1 feet along Lot 34 to an angle iron and ahu;
3. 91° 57' 30" 74.7 feet along North Road to an angle iron and ahu
4. 78° 45' 30" 94.1 feet along North Road to an angle iron and ahu
5. 58° 02' 30" 152.5 feet along North Road to an angle iron and ahu;
6. 39° 54' 30" 166.5 feet along North Road to an angle iron and ahu;
7. 38° 41' 30" 167.8 feet along North Road to an galvanized iron spike and ahu;
8. 145° 08' 3893.7 feet along Lot 32 to the point of beginning.
