Beginning at a pipe set in concrete at the East corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of L.C.A. 6112 Apana 2, to Isaac Neck, and at an angle in the South boundary of L.C.A. 2220 to Sila Kaikuaana, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Transit of Venus" being 2858.9 feet North and 2000.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 259, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 29° 23' 113.9 feet along L.C.A. 6112 Apana 2, to Isaac Neck, and L.C.A. 6755 Apana 2, to Waaloa, to a stake;
2. 117° 39' 260.2 feet along L.C.A. 7672 Apana 2, to Kaiaki, to a stake;
3. 214° 50' 134.1 feet along foot of pali to a + on rock;
4. 302° 06' 247.6 feet along L.C.A. 2220 to Sila Kaikuaana, to the point of beginning.
