Beginning at a Forest Reserve Monument (marked "Forest Ohia") at the Northwest corner of this lot, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kamakakaka" being: 8244.5 feet North and 5330.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2441, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 281° 49' 1238.0 feet along the Kau Forest Reserve to a Forest Reserve Monument (marked Forest Mud");
2. 318° 47' 30" 1145.0 feet along government land to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
3. 102° 35' 38.1 feet along North Road to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
4. 94° 33' 586.5 feet along North Road to an angle iron and ahu;
5. 94° 39' 351.2 feet along North Road to an angle iron and ahu;
6. 95° 30' 228.9 feet along North Road to an angle iron and ahu;
7. 122° 23' 117.6 feet along North Road to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
8. 133° 07' 193.8 feet along North Road to an angle iron and ahu; spike
9. 129° 12' 387.1 feet along North Road to a galvanized iron and ahu;
10. 120° 50' 549.9 feet along North Road to an angle iron and ahu;
11. 220° 38' 378.1 feet along Lot 33 to the point of beginning.
