Beginning at a redwood post at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 33, Government Survey Trig. Station "Paina" is by true azimuth and distance $27^{\circ} 48'$ 2788.8 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2262, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $87^{\circ} 50'$ 120.7 feet along Lot 32 to a redwood post;
2. $75^{\circ} 42'$ 105.4 feet along Lot 32 to a redwood post;
3. $182^{\circ} 10'$ 42.7 feet along Lot 31 to a redwood post;
4. $172^{\circ} 56'$ 239.3 feet along Lot 35 to a redwood post;
5. $259^{\circ} 16'$ 85.1 feet along trail and Hanalei River;
6. $242^{\circ} 45'$ 62.0 feet along trail and Hanalei River;
7. $335^{\circ} 45'$ 172.3 feet along Lot 33;
8. $343^{\circ} 19'$ 142.6 feet along Lot 33 to the initial point.
