Beginning at + on stone and ahu at the Northeast corner of Grant 1371, W.T.M.Koma, S  $53^{\circ} 47'$  E true 200 feet from N.E.Koma Trig. Station and triangle mark, said Trig. Station being S  $15^{\circ} 28' 30''$  E true from Akihi Trig. Station with coordinates 12008.1 feet S. and 3324.5 feet E; from said Akihi, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176 and running as follows by true bearings; all points being marked by + on stone and ahu; unless otherwise described:-

1. N  $38^{\circ} 18'$  E 916 feet along Lot 33; thence along Government reservation 60 feet wide, through which the Government road passes to a point which is
2. S  ~~$86^{\circ} 56'$~~   <sup>$87^{\circ} 05'$</sup>  E ~~1308~~ <sup>1303.5</sup> feet from the last station to + on pahoehoe and ahu; T.M.L. Mar 31/25
3. S  $16^{\circ} 43'$  W 378 feet along reservation for 40 foot road;
4. S  $11^{\circ} 2'$  E 487 feet along the same;
5. S  $10^{\circ} 59'$  E 352 feet along the same;
6. S  $83^{\circ} 47'$  W 1254 feet along Lot 35 to triangle mark on stone and ahu;
7. N  $88^{\circ} 7'$  W 704 feet along the same;
8. N  $2^{\circ} 35'$  E 645 feet along Grant 1371, W.T.M.Koma, to the initial point and containing an area of 50-5/10 Acres.
