Beginning at a mamane post at the North corner of this lot and the West corner of Lot 33 on the East side of Middle road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-e-Kali" being 9409.0 feet South and 11960.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2494, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 303° 27' 680.0 feet along Lot 33 to a mamane post;
2. 298° 16' 443.0 feet along L.C.A. 6540:2 to Halekahi to a point 3 feet from the center of right-of-way of the Kula Pipe Line;
3. Along a line parallel to and 3 feet from the center line of the right-of-way of the Kula Pipe Line to a mamane post, the direct azimuth and distance being 16° 38' 925.4 feet;
4. 129° 46' 1157.0 feet along Lot 36 to a mamane post on the East side of Middle road;
5. 222° 11' 38.3 feet along Middle road to a mamane post;
6. 195° 49' 162.0 feet along Middle road to a mamane post;
7. 235° 26' 125.0 feet along Middle road to a mamane post;
8. 129° 09' 232.0 feet along Middle road to a mamane post;
9. 211° 40' 388.0 feet along Middle road to the point of beginning.
