Hanalei Homesteads, Halelea, Kauai.

Beginning at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 23, from which a pipe at the Northwest corner of Lot 1 is by true azimuth and distance $360^{\circ} 00'$ 230.4 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2262, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $360^{\circ} 00'$ 137.8 feet along Lot 23;
2. $89^{\circ} 56'$ 113.3 feet along Lot 33A;
3. $109^{\circ} 54'$ 113.4 feet along Lot 33A;
4. $73^{\circ} 37'$ 285.6 feet along Lot 33 A;
5. $55^{\circ} 54'$ 274.6 feet along Lot 33A;
6. $165^{\circ} 32'$ 146.1 feet along Government land to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized pipe;
7. $194^{\circ} 21'$ 42.3 feet along Government land;
8. $252^{\circ} 00'$ 487.4 feet along Lot 35A;
9. $270^{\circ} 00'$ 284.7 feet along Lot 35A to the initial point.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a 40 foot right of way along the general line of the trail across this lot.
