Beginning at the Southwest corner of this lot, on the East side of an Eight Foot Roadway, said point of beginning being $280^{\circ} 08'$ 8.0 feet from a pipe set in concrete at the Southeast corner of Lot 36, and the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Transit of Venus" being 5498.9 feet North and 4019.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2598, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $185^{\circ} 10'$ 45.0 feet along an Eight Foot Roadway;
2. $272^{\circ} 55'$ 134.6 feet along L.C.A. 10721 Apana 1, to Kapapa;
3. $5^{\circ} 10'$ 62.0 feet along L.C.As. 10092, 10095 and 10640 to Mikolouka and Pakai;
4. $100^{\circ} 08'$ 135.0 feet along a roadway to the point of beginning.
