Beginning at an iron rail at the Northeast corner of this lot and on the West side of Huelo-Paia Government Road, the coordinates of said iron rail referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauhikoa" being 6985.3 feet North and 8171.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2542, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 324° 52' 1430.0 feet along Huelo-Paia Government Road;
2. 51° 43' 1336.0 feet along Lot 38 crossing Kolealea Gulch;
3. 99° 49' 848.1 feet along Lot 45, crossing Kaupakulua Gulch;
4. 176° 12' ^{1752.0}~~1750.0~~ feet along Lot 27; Kuiaha-Pauwela Homesteads;
5. 175° 42' 418.8 feet along Lot 32 to an iron rail on the West side of road;

Thence along the West side of road, the direct azimuths and distances being:

6. 340° 15' 429.6 feet;
7. 273° 50' 307.8 feet;
8. 6° 50' 531.5 feet;
9. 281° 40' 152.0 feet;
10. 218° 10' 152.0 feet;
11. 263° 20' 321.0 feet;
12. 206° 54' ^{571.3}~~571.3~~ feet to the point of beginning.

Excepting and reserving Kolealea and Kaupakulua Streams and all riparian and other rights in or to these streams and the waters thereof; also a strip of land 40 feet wide across this lot for the proposed new Huelo-Paia Government Road.
