Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot, on the South boundary of Lot 35, and the Northwest end of a 30 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniai" being 1883.3 feet North and 264.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $20^{\circ} 00'$ 915.2 feet along 30 foot road and Lot 33 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
2. $106^{\circ} 20'$ 834.7 feet along Lot 77 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. $205^{\circ} 29'$ 973.1 feet along East side of the Gravity Railroad right-of-way to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. $290^{\circ} 00'$ 740.0 feet along Lot 35 to the point of beginning.
