Revised Description.

Lot 36.

Hekalau Homesteads,  
5, Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at an iron rail at the West corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 34 and on the East side of 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 15085.4 feet North and 2674.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2574, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 238° 00' 1115.0 feet along Lots 34 and 33 to an iron rail;
2. 328° 00' 479.0 feet along Lot 32 to an iron rail 10 feet from edge of the Kaahakini Stream;
3. Along a line parallel to and 10 feet from edge of the Kaahakini Stream, the direct azimuth and distance being 47° 39' 1065.0 feet to an iron rail;
4. 138° 55' 360.0 feet along Lot 52 to an iron rail;
5. 238° 00' 40.0 feet across the end of 40 foot road to an iron rail;
6. 138° 55' 319.0 feet along 40 foot road to the point of beginning.
