Beginning at the Northeast corner of this lot and the East corner of Lot 38 near the top of the bank of the Hoopau Stream, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Paina" being 2151.0 feet North and 680.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2262, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $1^{\circ} 10'$ 127.7 feet along near top of bank of Hoopau Stream;
2. $72^{\circ} 15'$ 279.7 feet along Lot 25;
3. $72^{\circ} 00'$ 720.7 feet along Lot 35-A;
4. $157^{\circ} 51'$ 68.6 feet along government land;
5. $237^{\circ} 32'$ 230.0 feet along Lot 36-A;
6. $252^{\circ} 00'$ 457.8 feet along Lots 36-A and 38;
7. $239^{\circ} 05'$ 146.5 feet along Lot 38;
8. $261^{\circ} 42'$ 228.4 feet along same to the point of beginning.
