Lot 37.

Hakalau Homesteads,  
S. Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at an iron rail at the North corner of this lot, and the South corner of Mountain Road and a 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 16050.0 feet North and 1940.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2574, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 324° 35' 1207.0 feet along 40 foot road to an iron rail;
2. 318° 55' 280.5 feet along 40 foot road to an iron rail;
3. 58° 00' 553.0 feet along Lot 52 to an iron rail;
4. 147° 27' 1451.0 feet along Lot 38 to an iron rail on the South side of Mountain Road;
5. 226° 25' 109.0 feet along Mountain Road to an iron rail;
6. 230° 15' 155.0 feet along Mountain Road to an iron rail;
7. 241° 30' 190.0 feet along Mountain Road to the point of beginning.

Area 16-66/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide across this lot for the flume, said right-of-way containing an area of 11/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 16-55/100 ACRES.
