Beginning at a mamane post at the East corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 35 and on the West side of Polipoli road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Kali" being 11565.4 feet South and 13478.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2494, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 40° 15' 10.0 feet along Polipoli road to a mamane post;
2. 31° 58' 252.3 feet along Polipoli road to a mamane post;
3. 45° 51' 270.0 feet along Polipoli road to a mamane post;
4. 32° 56' 170.0 feet along Polipoli road to a mamane post;
5. 129° 46' 1045.4 feet along Lot 38 to a mamane post 3 feet from center of right-of-way of the Kula Pipe Line;
6. Along a line 3 feet from and parallel to the center line of the right-of-way of the Kula Pipe Line to a mamane post, the direct azimuth and distance being 215° 39' 700.0 feet;
7. 309° 46' 1070.0 feet along Lot 35 to the point of beginning.
