Station "Transit of Venus" being 5129.9 feet North and 3449.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2598, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 182° 30' 430.0 feet along the East side of the Valley Road;
2. 276° 50' 70.0 feet along L.C.A. 9201, Ap. 2, to Kumukou;
3. 5° 17' 330.0 feet along L.C.A. 9191, to Maka;
4. 32° 05' 109.0 feet along the West bank of the Waimea River to the point of beginning.
