Beginning at a mamane post at the South corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 18 and on the land of Kamaole, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Kali" being 12968.1 feet South and 12446.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2494, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $114^{\circ} 35'$ 1270.0 feet along the land Kamaole to a point 3 feet from center of right-of-way of the Kula Pipe Line;
2. Along a line parallel to and 3 feet from the center line of the right-of-way of the Kula Pipe Line to a mamane post, the direct azimuth and distance being $224^{\circ} 01'$ 1377.7 feet;
3. $309^{\circ} 46'$ 1045.4 feet along Lot 37 to a mamane post on the West side of Polipoli road;
4. $35^{\circ} 29'$ 1044.2 feet along Polipoli road and along Lot 18 to the point of beginning.
