Beginning at a 1½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Government Reserve, on the South side of Government Main Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniai" being 3169.3 feet North and 1156.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 23° 33' 272.8 feet along Government Reserve to a 1½ inch pipe;
2. 293° 33' 549.5 feet along Government Reserve to a 1½ inch pipe;
3. 23° 33' 370.0 feet along the Gravity Railroad right-of-way to a 1½ inch pipe;
4. 113° 33' 48.6 feet along same to a 1½ inch pipe;
5. 25° 29' 470.0 feet along same to a 1½ inch pipe;
6. 113° 33' 785.4 feet along Lot 37 to a 1½ inch pipe;
7. 203° 33' 1176.5 feet along Lot 39 to a 1½ inch pipe;
8. 287° 00' 40.6 feet along South side of Government Main Road to a 1½ inch pipe;
9. 308° 15' 269.0 feet along South side of Government Main Road to the point of beginning.
