KIOLAKAA-KEAA HOMESTEAD LOTS.

Lot 39.

Beginning at angle in stone wall, at South corner of Grant 1373, Kapunoho, N 15° 16' E true 16 feet from Uewale Trig. Station and triangle mark on large flat rock, said Trig. Station being S 18° 25' 30" E true, from Lolena-nui Trig. Station and having for coordinates referred to Akihi Trig. Station 16504.5 feet S. and 21397.0 feet E., as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running as follows by true bearings:-

1. S 53° 27' W 745 feet along Grant ²⁵⁷³ Manunu to + on rock;
2. N 31° 14' W 1953 feet along Grant 2409, Kapule, to corner of stone wall;
3. N 35° 20' W 1920 feet along stone wall by Grant 2458, Kamale, to + on rock by corner of said stone wall;
4. N 48° 0' E 1220 feet along Grant 819, J. Kauhiahiwa to + on stone and ahu;
5. S 32° 35' E 1510 feet along Grant 1531, Kaluapala, to corner of stone wall;
6. S 23° 13' E 2540 feet along stone wall by Grant 1373 to the initial point and containing an area of 91-9/10 Acres.
