Beginning at a pipe set in concrete, at the Southwest corner of this lot, on the East side of the Valley road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Transit of Venus" being 5745.9 feet North and 3430.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2598, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 174° 00' 160.0 feet along East side of the Valley Road;
2. 270° 45' 428.0 feet along L.C.A. 9186, to Keauaunui;
3. 42° 40' 216.0 feet along the West bank of the Waimea River;
4. 91° 15' 265.0 feet along L.C.A. 9201, Ap.2, to Kumukou, to the point of beginning.
