Beginning at a mamane post at the North corner of this lot and on the East side of Koheo road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Kali" being: 1144.5 feet South and 17498.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2494, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 297° 06' 1465.0 feet along the land of Koheo to a mamane post 3 feet from the center of the right-of-way of the Kula Pipe Line;
2. Along a line parallel to and 3 feet from the center line of the right-of-way of the Kula Pipe Line to a mamane post, the direct azimuth and distance being: 0° 28' 370.0 feet;
3. 127° 56' 240.0 feet along L.C.A. 6738:3 to Luheluhe to a mamane post;
4. 36° 55' 98.3 feet along L.C.A. 6738:3 to Luheluhe to a mamane post;
5. 33° 55' 310.2 feet along L.C.A. 6543:5 to Hoopiopio to a mamane post;
6. 131° 37' 1179.0 feet along Lot 40 to a mamane post on the East side of Koheo road;
7. 175° 20' 317.0 feet along Koheo road to a mamane post;
8. 192° 13' 130.0 feet along Koheo road to the point of beginning.
