Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot, at the Southeast corner of Upper Kalopa Road and Government Main Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniai" being 3386.8 feet North and 2741.1 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $278^{\circ} 15'$ 685.6 feet along South side of Government Main Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
2. $262^{\circ} 25'$ 597.4 feet along same to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. $287^{\circ} 00'$ 66.5 feet along same to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. $23^{\circ} 33'$ 1341.5 feet along Lots 38 and 37 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
5. $147^{\circ} 49' 30''$ 1499.1 feet along Northeast side of Upper Kalopa Road to the point of beginning.
