Revised Description.

Lot 39.

Hakalau Homesteads,
South Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at an iron rail at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 38 and on the South side of Mountain Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 15445.0 feet North and 1170.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2574, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 328° 00' 2177.0 feet along Lots 38 and 52 to an iron rail 10 feet from the edge of the Kaahakini Stream;
2. Along a line parallel to and 10 feet from the edge of the Kaahakini stream, the direct azimuth and distance being: 89° 55' 391.2 feet to an iron rail;
3. 148° 00' 1837.0 feet along Lot 40 to an iron rail on the South side of Mountain Road;
4. 213° 25' 110.0 feet along Mountain Road to an iron rail;
5. 217° 20' 248.0 feet along Mountain Road to the point of beginning.

Area 15-76/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom rights-of-way 10 feet wide across this lot for the flumes, said rights-of-way containing an area of 10/100 acre.

Also Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide across this lot for the roadway, said right-of-way containing an area of 01/100 acre.
