Beginning at angle in stone wall at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Grant 1373 to Kapunoho and at an angle on the Northwest boundary of Grant 2573 to Manunu, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Akihi" being 16489.1 feet South and 21461.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $53^{\circ} 27'$ 745.0 feet along Grant 2573 to Manunu to + on rock;
2. $148^{\circ} 46'$ 1953.0 feet along Grant 2409 to Kapule to corner of stone wall;
3. $144^{\circ} 40'$ 573.0 feet along Grant 2458 to Kamale to $\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. $234^{\circ} 40'$ 20.0 feet along end of 20 Foot Road;
5. $235^{\circ} 47'$ 1119.0 feet along Lot 39-A to 1 inch pipe at corner of wall;
6. $336^{\circ} 47'$ 2540.0 feet along Grant 1373 to Kapunoho to the point of beginning.
